It was the first time that our new school banner has been used with many more ANZAC Day marches ahead. It is extremely important to continue our strong school tradition of support and participation in ANZAC Day remembrance services. A special shout out to all Kindergarten students who participated in their first school ANZAC Day march the future is in great hands!

Our school leaders did a magnificent job leading the service and we are most grateful to Lieutenant Craig Daniel from HMAS Albatross for taking the time to give his impactful commemorative address.

Staffing

We welcome Ms Janelle Pickwick as a new permanent appointment to Culburra PS. Ms Pickwick will be teaching all classes in her role as the release from face-to-face teacher. Ms Pickwick is an experienced educator and is a welcome addition to our school.

Staff Development Day

Like all public schools across the state, the team at CPS participated in professional learning based on the new curriculum. Our areas of focus were Effective multiple-choice assessment to inform teaching, Supporting students with disability in the curriculum and Assessing and monitoring writing across the curriculum. New learning in these areas will support the implementation of the new curriculum and the teaching and learning cycle.

Attendance

The following information is feedback regarding student attendance based on data from the second half of Term 1. With a current enrolment of 204 students, the overall attendance rate was 91.7% (5% above the state average). The number of students attending school greater than 90% was 69.1% (14% above the state average). In the final week of Term 1, class 5/6E had 100% attendance which is magnificent, and classes KW and 5/6D had 100% attendance 4 out of the 5 days which is also a fantastic effort. There are a number of students who have maintained 100% attendance in Term 1 and this will be acknowledged with an attendance award at this week's assembly. Most of the scholastic years (5 out of 7 grades from Kindergarten to Year 6) maintained an attendance average above 90% throughout the second half of the term. Kindergarten students had the highest overall attendance percentage of 93.7%. Compared to the same period in 2023, our overall attendance rate remains close to the same and the percentage of students attending greater than 90% has increased by 7%. There will be a continued focus on explanation of absences, many thanks to all parents and carers who promptly message using the school's email address, Compass app or a phone message. Every day at school counts, let's continue to build on a pleasing attendance start to the school vear.
