# Principal's Report

#### Art Show

Our recent art show was a huge success, all students contributed quality artwork and the class major artwork projects were amazing. A very big thank you to students, staff and parents/carers for helping to make it such a success. Purchased student artwork will be sent home on Monday 4th December.

#### 2024 Leaders

Congratulations to all students in Year 5 who have nominated for a leadership position in 2024. Well done for running a weekly assembly to such a high standard. The students will be informed of the results this Friday 1st December and the school community will be notified of the successful candidates in Week 10.

#### **Student Lighthouses**

A reminder for all students to hand in their lighthouse slips this week for the annual lighthouse draw at this week's assembly. This will be our last assembly for the year.

#### **Attendance Data Update**

Latest attendance data indicates that our school's attendance rate is above state, network and 'like schools' rate. The number of students attending greater than 90% is also substantially above state, network and 'like schools' rate with a range of 12%-14%. Further to this, there has been a downward shift in the number of unexplained absences. This number was quite high in Term 1 and since the introduction of the daily Compass app the number of unexplained absences has nearly halved. We are on track to continue this very pleasing trend into the second half of term 4. Parents/carers of Year 6 students have excelled in this area with only two unexplained absences this term for the cohort. Well done everyone - let's keep up the great work as we head into the final three weeks of our school year.

#### Kindergarten 2024

Congratulations to our amazing future kindergarten students who have completed their orientation program. We are so excited to have them with us next year, each child did an

amazing job during their visits and we are so proud of them! I wish to acknowledge the team led by Mrs Carter for their outstanding organisation and communication leading to such a successful program for the children.

#### Swim Scheme

Congratulations to all students who participated in the recent swim scheme program. Our students worked hard to improve their practical skills and I was extremely pleased to receive positive feedback regarding how well our students represented our school with their outstanding behaviour over the course of two weeks - well done everyone!
