Attendance

Our attendance data from the second half of last term remains positive. The overall attendance rate for all students was 2% above the state average, and 5% above the network average. The percentage of students attending greater than 90% is 57%. This is just under 2% above the state average and 6% above the network average. The focus on attendance remains with explanation for any student absence provided to the school within three days of being away from school, a very big-thank you for your continued support in this area.
